Updating the Standard

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Clause 3 – General requirements

3.4a After the second labelling designation: "... דל" (meaning "low ...") or "מופחת" (meaning, "reduced ..."), the following labelling designation shall be added:
"דל מאוד בנתרן" (meaning "very low sodium").

Clause 10 – Nutrition marking

The following paragraph shall be added at the end of the clause:

A nutrition marking on a food in accordance with the abovementioned Public Health Regulations shall not be considered as a nutritional argument regarding food labelling with the designations specified in clause 3.4a above.

Annex B – Labelling of the food product with the designations given in subclause 3.4a

- The Annex heading shall be deleted and shall be superseded by the following:

Labelling of the food product^(12a) with the designations given in subclause 3.4a

- After footnote 12, footnote 12a shall be added as follows:

^(12a) The term 'food product' in this Annex does not include drinking water in containers, including water covered by the Public Health Regulations (Mineral water and spring water), 1986, with their updates, or any other law superseding them.

Clause B-1

- The first sentence shall be deleted and shall be superseded by the following:

The labelling of the product with the designations: "נטול" (meaning, "...free"),
"ללא" (meaning, "no ..."),
"דל" (meaning, "low ..."),
"מופחת" (meaning, "reduced ...")

(with the addition of the relevant material name) and the designation:

"דל מאוד בנתרן" (meaning "very low sodium") shall be in accordance with that specified in Table B-1.

- The second sentence shall be deleted and shall be superseded by the following:

A product which, from the point of view of its sodium content, complies with the requirements specified for "נתרן ..." (meaning, "... sodium"), and is marked with this designation may be marked, in addition, with the designation:
"מלח ..." (meaning "... salt") (with the addition of the relevant adjective).

Clause B-3

- The first sentence shall be deleted and shall be superseded by the following:

A product marked with the designation: "... דל" (meaning, "low ...") or with the designation "ללא" (meaning, "no ...") (with the addition of the relevant material from among the following: sodium or salt or fat⁽¹³⁾), or with the designation:
"דל מאוד בנתרן" (meaning "very low sodium"), may be marked, in addition, with the

designation "... לדִיאטָה דלת" (meaning, "for a low ... diet") or "... לדִיאטָה ללא" (meaning, "for a no ... diet") (with the addition of the relevant material from among the materials indicated above⁽¹⁴⁾).

Table B-1 – Labelling food products with the designations: "... נטול" (meaning, "... free"), "... ללא" (meaning, "no ..."), "... דל" (meaning, "low ..."), "... מופחת" (meaning, "reduced ...")

- The table heading shall be deleted and shall be superseded by the following:
Table B-1 – Labelling food products with the designations: "... נטול" (meaning, "... free"), "... ללא" (meaning, "no ..."), "... דל" (meaning, "low ..."), "... מופחת" (meaning, "reduced ..."), "דל מאוד בנתרן" (meaning "very low sodium").
- The heading of column B ("Significance of the designation") shall be deleted and shall be superseded by the following:
Significance of the designation and labelling conditions
- In column D of the table for the designation: "... דל" (meaning, "low ..."), in row A, the line before the last line beginning with the word "sodium" shall be deleted and shall be superseded by the following:
sodium up to 120 mg in 100 g
- In column A, after the line in the table for the designation: "... דל" (meaning, "low ..."), a new line shall be added with four columns, as follows:

- In the line of the table in column A to the designation: "מופחת ..." (meaning, "reduced ..."), the line before the last in column D beginning with the words "sodium content" shall be deleted.
- After the line of the table in column A to the designation: "מופחת ..." (meaning, "reduced ...", a new line of four columns shall be added to the table as specified below:

The information, required below, shall be marked next to the "reduced sodium" comparative nutritional claim, and shall be of uniform emphasis and letter size not smaller than two thirds (2/3) of the letter size of the "reduced sodium" comparative nutritional claim, but not less than the letter/numeral size of the ingredients labelling.</p> <p>Information required:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The extent of the quantitative difference expressed as a percentage or a fraction. 2. Identification of the food(s) to which the food is compared shall be marked in sufficient detail for the consumers to easily identify them. 		

- Note (C) in the table shall be deleted and shall be superseded by the following:

(C) Namely, a reduction of at least 25% was obtained, in comparison with the similar food product(s).
